

English

Look for writing in your local environment for your child to sound out and read.

Read a wide range of books with your child on a daily basis and talk about the books. Can your child tell you the main events of the story? Can they predict what might happen?

Make up silly rhymes and songs- have fun!

Encourage your child to help you write lists and labels at home when you go shopping or for birthdays.

Mathematics

Look for shapes and numbers in the environment for example house numbers; are they odd or even, what do they go up in?

Play shops with pretend money and look at real coins.

Practise counting objects in 1s, and then 2s, 5s and 10s.

Talk about what we do at different times of the day. How long do certain activities take, for example, brushing

Science

Encourage a curiosity of the world around us.

Go for a walk and look at all the natural materials. Can you make some natural art?

What senses are you using on your walk?

Look at trees and plants and try to identify some of them.

PSHE

Talk to your children about comfortable and uncomfortable

feelings including problems with friendships and how they can deal with them through seeking help and support from an adult.

R.E

Visit different religious buildings. Introduce the term faith. Allow children to share their own values and beliefs and discuss why it is important to respect beliefs of other people.

Music

Listen to a wide range of music with your child. Clap along to the rhythm.

P.E

Encourage your child to be as active as possible. Ride a bike, play throwing and catching games and visit local parks.

History

Talk with grandparents. What was it like when they were young? How did they travel to school? What holidays did they have?

Computing

Talk about how we stay safe when using technology.

Use internet search engines to find out about things that interest them.

Talk about different technology we use at home.

Art and Design

Use different pens, pencils and paints to do observational drawings. Look and talk about different paintings and artists.

Design and Technology

Use junk to make models. What it it and how does it work? How could you make it better?

Geography

Talk about your holidays and journeys while looking at maps, globes and atlases.

Walk around the village looking at new and old buildings.
