Understanding the World

We will also be following the children's interests in determining our learning.

Literacy/English

Using books with repeating patterns and stories in familiar settings children will learn how to describe settings, characters, anticipate events and recognise rhyme. Children will have fun creating labels, making signs and lists and learn when, how and why to use labels and captions.

Mathematics

We will be covering the following reception topics;

- **Number and place value**-recognising and counting numbers up to 5.
- **Addition and subtraction**- change within 5
- **Number**- sorting and comparing groups.
- **measurement** - time.

Year 1's will be looking at these topics within 20.

Communication and Language

Through teacher-led activities and show and tell, the role play area and book corner, the children will have the opportunity to experience a rich language environment through speaking and listening, and to develop their confidence and skills in expressing themselves. New vocabulary will be introduced through our topics.

Expressive arts and design

Art-Children will create self-portraits. They will begin to look at mixing primary colours. Being Inspired by Lois Wain's work, we will be producing printed images of our school.

Music- We will explore beat and tempo through a range of songs and rhymes. We will learn Christmas songs for a performance.
