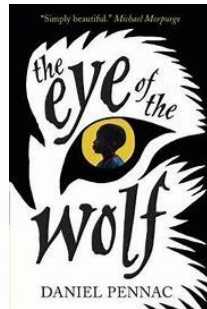
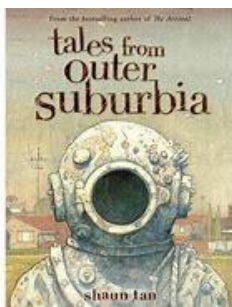

### English

This summer term, we will be exploring a range of texts, including Tales From Outer Suburbia by Shaun Tan and Eye of the Wolf by Daniel Pennac.



### Maths



Our taught maths content this term include:

### Science

#### Properties and changes of materials

Children will learn about the wider properties of materials and their uses. They will learn about mixtures and how they can be separated using sieving, filtration and evaporation. They will study reversible and irreversible changes, and use common indicators to identify irreversible changes.

## History/ Geography Projects

This project teaches children about developments and changes over six periods of ancient Greek history, focusing on the city state of Athens in the Classical age, and exploring the lasting legacy of ancient Greece.

## Art and Design

Children will learn about paper crafts, papermaking and collage techniques, including paper, fabric, mixed media and photo collage. They then use their learning to create a final piece of small-scale, mixed media collage. Additionally, children will explore the Expressionist art movement and Edvard Munch.

## Design and Technology

Throughout this unit, children will learn about how architectural style and technology has developed over time and then use this knowledge to design a building with specific features.

## Computing

This term, the children will continue to develop their skills and confidence when using Google Classroom, focusing on Google Sheets. They will later move onto a unit in which they will learn to create a digital quiz.

## PE

During the summer term, children will participate in athletics, tennis and rounders.

Our PE days are Tuesdays and Wednesdays. PE kits should be kept in school throughout the week and every item of kit should be **clearly named**.

## PSHE/RSE

Through our Economic Wellbeing topic, children will explore different career roles and risks associated with money. During our Transition topic, pupils will consider the opportunities that their new year group brings and how to cope with change.



## RE

Children will explore sacred texts and stories, reviewing their guidance and impact. They will also explore different ideas about God and Gods, creation and ultimate questions. Additionally, they will reflect on ethics, what is right and wrong, just and fair.

## Music

In the summer units, children will develop further confidence with improvisation, focusing on phrasing and dynamics.

## French

Through the units 'At School' and 'The Weekend', children will further develop their vocabulary and understanding of grammar.
