Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our Home Learning Policy, which is available on our school website, we have an expectation that each child will produce a presentation for their class over the course of the school year. This was introduced three years ago and the children have spoken about a range of topics including their grandparents, their pets, an interest they had and much, much more. These presentations are shared in a weekly assembly to the child's class on Tuesdays. These presentations were mentioned in our recent Ofsted report as something that children value.

When the children present to their class, the audience will be expected to listen and ask relevant questions. We find that this task gives children a good opportunity to develop public speaking skills as well as sharing something that interests them. Some children who have previously been reluctant to speak in front of the class really surprised us – and possibly themselves! It also gave their friends a good opportunity to find about children and their interests. The activity also practises the skills of asking and answering questions.

This does require parental support to be successful but it is not home learning for you! We ask that you spend time with your child preparing for their presentation as it forms part of their home learning. They can produce a PowerPoint if they wish to, bring in any resources to support their presentation and be as creative as they wish! Any Powerpoint slides can be emailed to admin@pirton.herts.sch.uk and we ask that you email these by the previous Friday afternoon to give us time to iron out any technical issues! They can bring in physical objects including photos and other objects.

These presentations start in Autumn Term 2. In Autumn Term 1, teachers will teach children the appropriate skills of speaking to an audience and how to engage and project their voices.

We keep a visual record of the presentations in the classrooms which can be viewed at Book Look and Parents Evening.
